Well, the answer is "desk," which is No. 2. OK? Let's begin.

Welcome to today's broadcast of Wacky News. Today we have a story about a singing dog. Bernie is a small brown dog with a very big voice! But he doesn't make noises like a regular dog. Bernie sings. When his owner puts music on, Bernie just loves to sing along. His favorite artist is Jim Cracker. Bernie will sing along from the moment a Jim Cracker song starts, right up until it ends. His owners can't listen to music at night anymore because Bernie's singing is so loud that it disturbs the neighbors. What a dog!

Question: Who does Bernie like to sing with?

Good morning, everyone. Welcome to Sea Life Aquarium. Here, we have various exciting attractions. One of them is Shark Cage Adventure. In our shark tank, you can swim with the sharks in a steel cage which protects you. All you need to bring for this unique experience is a sense of adventure. We'll provide a training time, so you don't need any previous diving experience. All the equipment for the activity is also provided. The next session will start in one hour. We hope you'll have a great time with the sharks!

Question: What are you required to bring for Shark Cage Adventure?

Recently consumers have become highly aware of the laws of supply and demand. When everyone suddenly wanted masks, many stores ran out. However, once more companies devoted resources to making them, masks became available again. A similar pattern happened with toilet paper. Consumers started to panic when they could not find it on store shelves. Again, the problem of demand being greater than supply did not last long, but it did scare many people. More recently, 3 hospital patients were having trouble getting oxygen. To reduce the oxygen demand and allow it to be available to people in need, many car manufacturers temporarily reduced or halted their production. When situations like these occur, remember the problem is temporary and be patient. Question: What problem was the speaker talking about? Food delivery is becoming extremely common. Many people don't realize how much more they are paying for food delivery. The same pizza that people ordered last year costs 1000 yen more this year. The pizza delivery fees in many areas have also increased by 500 yen per delivery. Many customers don't realize that restaurants are charging more for an item being delivered than for an item being eaten at the restaurant. The restaurants are then adding on an additional fee for the 4 delivery service. A meal that costs me 1200 yen to eat at my favorite restaurant costs me 2000 yen when it's delivered to me. This month I've saved money eating that meal at my favorite restaurant three times. Question: How much money has the speaker saved this month by not having the meals delivered? In many countries, elderly people are respected. It's the same here in Japan where September 15th is "Respect for the Aged Day." Of course, there are many reasons to respect the elderly. They were born when our country was not rich, have experienced the Second World War, and worked very hard after it. They established the basis of our country. By the way, there is a restaurant which offered a very funny service to senior citizens. The 5 restaurant offered any food free to customers over 80 years old. However, there was one strict condition for the free service. The visiting senior customers had to take their parents with them! I

wonder how many customers took advantage of the service. Maybe it was some kind of joke.
